What is Books by Mail?



Homebound Books by Mail is a program that provides library materials to Washington County, VA residents, regardless of age, who are unable to visit one of our libraries due to a temporary or long-term physical or medical disability, or due to an extreme lack of transportation.

Eligible potential users may receive a catalog which lists materials available for lending by the library. The catalogs are updated and distributed semi-annually, and contain a breakdown as to type of materials, as well as a brief description of the items.

Materials are available in many formats, including books on cassette tape, books on compact disc, both standard and large print books, music cassettes and CDs, and craft pamphlets.

The service uses standard mail delivery for your orders, and a free postage paid return to the lender. The loan period is three weeks.

Who is eligible for Books by Mail?



The Washington County Public Library System has contracted with Lonesome Pine Regional Library to provide homebound delivery of library materials to patrons who meet certain eligibility requirements.

ELIGIBILITY:

You may qualify for this service if you are:

A Washington County, VA resident in good standing with the library

Temporarily or permanently disabled

Homebound by reason of extended illness

Homebound because of extreme lack of transportation

You are a parent or caregiver of a homebound person of any age

Unable to access other Library Outreach services.



How do I sign up for Books by Mail?



Contact the Outreach Coordinator at the Washington County Public Library at (276) 676-6236, to request a catalog and registration form.

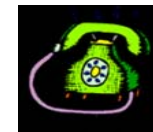
Once you have completed and returned the registration card to the Library, you may begin ordering through the Homebound Books by Mail Program. The initial order form is contained in the catalog. After your first order, you will be placed on the mailing list and will receive an updated catalog twice each year.

Each delivery you receive will contain a print-out of materials borrowed, a new order form, tape and a postage-paid return mailing label.

A Washington County library card is not required for this service, but is encouraged, so that patrons can make full use of all available resources.

Please note that the Mailbox Library is unable to provide materials beyond those listed in the catalog.
